HOPE's presence in New York City reflects a sustained and growing commitment to advancing Latina leadership and representation. Since launching Latina History Day New York in 2021, the event has become a recognized and anticipated convening—celebrating Latina achievements, earning state recognition, and contributing to the broader dialogue through key reports, including [The Economic Status of Latinas in New York](#) and [Latina Representation in New York Government](#).

Now in its fifth year, the 2026 Luncheon will welcome 120 to 150 leaders, professionals, and community members for an afternoon of connection, recognition, and continued momentum for Latina leadership in New York. This year's theme will explore the evolving nature of leadership and the future of democracy, featuring the launch of the *Bill of Rights for Our Future* project.

5th Annual **LATINA HISTORY DAY** **NEW YORK**

June 17, 2026

The **5th Annual Latina History Day New York** brings together leaders from the corporate, nonprofit, and public sectors for an afternoon of conversation on the evolving nature of leadership and the future of democracy.

This year's event will spotlight **HOPE's *Bill of Rights for Our Future* project**, a multidisciplinary art project that amplifies bold ideas from legal scholars, public servants, activists, and entrepreneurs, combining portrait photography by Camila Falquez with text by Julianne Escobedo Sheppard, under the creative vision of Helen Iris Torres.

As the United States approaches its 250th anniversary, HOPE convened 11 leaders to reflect on the enduring principles of the Bill of Rights and envision the rights our future demands. The project is led by Hispanas Organized for Political Equality (HOPE), with support from The James Irvine Foundation and the Latina Futures 2050 Lab.



Past Programming

Building on the impact of our past panels discussions, attendees engage with featured influential Latina leaders driving change across industries. Each year, HOPE works to continue to uplift and empower our communities through insightful discussions and inspiring conversations.



2023

ECONOMIC STATUS OF LATINAS

Building on the release of HOPE's 2023 Economic Status of Latinas Report for the State of New York, this discussion examined key national, state, and regional indicators shaping the economic well-being of Latinas in New York. Featuring leaders from private banking, nonprofits, and government, the conversation delved into strategies for advancing economic equity and fostering long-term prosperity.



2024

LATINA LEADERSHIP IN NEW YORK GOVERNMENT

HOPE's Latina Leadership in New York Government Report provided an in-depth analysis of Latina representation among more than 6,000 elected officials statewide. This panel brought together key Latina leaders to discuss the findings, highlight progress, and examine ongoing challenges in achieving greater political representation. The conversation built on HOPE's efforts to advance Latina leadership office across New York and nationwide.



2025

ECONOMIC MOBILITY AND LATINA LEADERSHIP PATHWAYS IN NEW YORK

This panel convened cross-sector leaders to explore opportunities and barriers shaping economic mobility and leadership pathways for Latinas in the state. Panelists shared insights on systemic challenges from access to capital and affordable housing to advancement into senior leadership while emphasizing the importance of collaboration. Speakers reinforced that advancing Latina economic mobility is a driver of New York's economic growth, closing with a call for continued collaboration.
